- Which news outlets interviewed attorneys from your firm about legal matters?
- Do you have any client testimonials available or clients I could speak to for a reference?

### RECENT RESULTS

- How many personal injury jury trials has your firm had in the last 12 months?
- What is the largest result your firm achieved for a client in the last 12 months?
- How much money has your firm recovered in total for your clients in the past 12 months?

### PROCEDURES

- What procedures do you have in place to ensure cases move as quickly as possible without sacrificing value?
- How and when do you investigate insurance coverage and assets?
- Should my case require, how much is the firm willing and able to advance in case expenses?

### CASE SPECIFIC

- How long do you expect my case would take?
- Which professionals have you worked with as witnesses in cases similar to this one?
- What potential weaknesses do you see in this case, and what are your plans to overcome them?
