
MOTORCYCLE ACCIDENTS vs. CAR ACCIDENTS in North Carolina


Whether you cruise down the open road on a motorcycle or in a minivan, here are some alarming facts you should know about the dangers and differences between motorcycles and cars in the Tar Heel State.



In North Carolina, motorcycle crashes are about 2.5x more likely to result in injury and **15x** more likely to be fatal than car crashes.

There are fewer motorcycles than cars on North Carolina roads, but the wrecks involving dangerous than car wrecks.




Nationwide, 5x more motorcycles are involved in fatal crashes than cars and bikers are 6x more likely to die in crashes.

and motorcycle accidents. Bikers in particular have to watch out for the following situations:






